Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for this award:

- 1. Be a current or former female student of AACC pursing a bachelor's degree and eligible for junior standing or higher by Fall 2019 at an accredited college or university;
- 2. Be a resident of Anne Arundel County;
- 3. Have a grade point average of 3.00 or higher;
- 4. Show evidence of financial need;
- 5. Show evidence of professionalism via extracurricular activities (employment or volunteer).

An interested candidate is asked to:

- 1. Fill out the attached application,
- 2. Attach a copy of her transcript from AACC and any other post-high school institution she may have attended,
- 3. Be available for an interview by the Transfer Scholarship Committee in early April 2019,
- 4. Attach a one page essay outlining educational and career goals. Include any present activities that have helped you make these choices. It is hoped the essay will mention how the applicant's personal goals match the objectives of AAUW.
