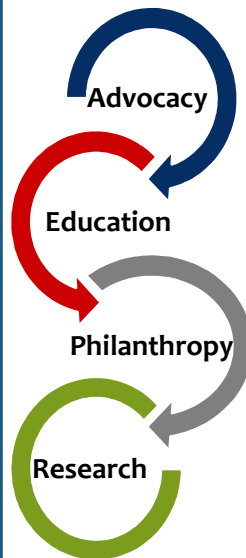
### What is AAUW?
