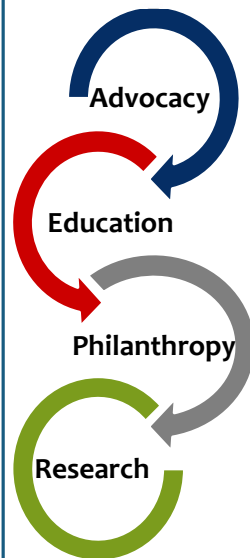
## What is AAUW?
